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2 Introduction

The present document constitutes the Deliverable D7.3. 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3 Identity toolkit

Next, a description of main elements which jointly create the Project Identity toolkit.

3.1 Element 01. Project logo(s) and manual of visual identity

The project logo was created following initial indications from the consortium. The proposed brand is composed of several premises suggested by EBSI-VECTOR consortium. Hence, it claims that concepts such as "education" and "social security" (from respective use cases), appear integrated into the brand through a symbol combining both. Hence, a half cross symbolizing social security and a graduation manifold represents education. The small outer nodes reflect the technological connection with blockchain. The third use case related to "business registries" is included as part of the "text section" combined with the "graphical section" of the logo "education and **work** reloaded". As a result, the project logo is presented below on several versions (Figure 1, Figure 2 and Figure 3).




Figure 7. Overview of updated "minutes template"




Figure 8. EBSI-VECTOR Power Point presentation – template
