Who we are

The **EBSI-VECTOR** (EBSI-enabled Verifiable Credentials and Trusted Organisations Registries) project is a **two-year-long initiative** that harnesses the self-sovereign identity paradigm to transform digital interactions within the educational and social security sectors. With a **consortium of 54 Organisations**, Public Bodies, SMEs and Large private entities, from **20 different European countries**, the project aims to streamline European citizens' digital experiences, simplifying complex verification processes. Through decentralisation and collaboration, our project empowers citizens and organisations, offering a secure, privacy-friendly, and efficient experience. It will be tested in **3 use cases**: *Education, Social security Business registries*.

EBSI-VECTOR at the Belgian EBSI Demystifying Seminar



EBSI-VECTOR took part in the **Belgian EBSI Demystifying Seminar!** This event explored the potential of EBSI and EUROPEUM-EDIC to enhance European digital sovereignty. The seminar featured contributions from EBSI-VECTOR participants, with insights shared by Daniel Du Seuil and Evrim Tan (KU Leuven).

One key takeaway was the emphasis on how EBSI can improve the efficiency of the public sector. The discussions also highlighted the importance of enabling **cross-border use cases**, such as verifiable credentials, to ensure seamless **interoperability** across Europe. EBSI-VECTOR is a project leading the way, with **pilots underway in education and social security**, paving the way for broader adoption of these technologies

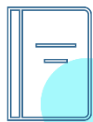
How to engage with us
